Dreams with the Mahanta

The eighth type of dream is those with the Mahanta.

The ECK, or Holy Spirit, can be known through Light and Sound. An inner experience with either of these two aspects is actually the presence of the Mahanta, in visible or audible form. When the Light and Sound combine, they form into a single matrix which shows up on the inner planes as the Mahanta, the Inner Master.

An ECK dreamer had often met the Mahanta on the inner planes but avoided him out of shyness and fear. One night in the dream state she attended a HU Chant in a large hall. People were going to be gathering to sing HU together, the ancient love song to God. Chairs were being set up in several areas, and the people were able to sit where they chose.

The woman selected a certain area and headed in that direction. When she got there, she found the chairs arranged in very disorderly fashion. People were scattered about, sitting here and there; everything was in chaos.

The HU Chant wasn't ready to begin yet, so she decided to leave the hall for a few minutes. As she started to cross the street, she met a few of her friends. They all got into a gondola, the kind used to transport skiers up a slope.

She felt the sensation of being lifted from the ground, and soon the vehicle was gone. In fact, everything was gone. She continued to move very high, very fast, but now there was a noticeable increase in vibration.

This vibration was the Sound of ECK uplifting this person. What started as a dream had turned into a direct experience with the Sound, which showed Itself as vibration.

A few minutes later she found herself back in the body on the plane where the dream had begun. She returned to the hall in time for the HU Chant, but this time she went to an area where the chairs were arranged in an orderly circle. All the seats were taken, except for one, and she knew it was hers. She sat down, and the HU Chant began.

In the circle was the Mahanta, the Inner Master; but because of her old fears of unworthiness, she kept her eyes down. Then something made her glance up. Looking his way, she suddenly had a feeling of recognition: She had known the Master before, in many lifetimes. She even recollected that he had once printed her wedding invitations.

Rather than an outer marriage, she knew the invitations had been for Soul to be linked up with the ECK. The image actually symbolized an inner marriage between Soul and the Holy Spirit.

For the first time in her experiences on the inner planes, she looked directly into the Master's eyes, and the fear went away. She had reached the degree of unfoldment that allowed her to surrender to the divine principle which operated within her at all times.

The Gentlest Dream Technique

The gentlest technique I know is to say, "Mahanta, you have my permission to take me to a Temple of Golden Wisdom for my spiritual benefit."

As a student of ECK, I often used this technique to visit new places in the higher worlds. It works best when said at night before rest. Issue it as a thought command. Give the Inner Master permission to guide you to a celestial place that fits your state of consciousness. Then go to sleep. The next morning see if you remember even what seems to be a most humdrum event.

Daily practice will sharpen recall of the hours you spend each night outside the cramped human shell.
